

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MOTION 10/16/2017

Marianne Fitzgerald moved, Katherine Christensen seconded, Jim Gardner thirded. All in favor except for Wes McMullen, who abstained. (9 votes in favor?)

That SWNI support reallocating funding from the Barbur Demonstration Project to construct SW 26th (from I-5 to Taylors Ferry Road) to meet the needs of all vulnerable road users. The project design must include sidewalks on one side of the street, bicycle paths on both sides of the street, and stormwater management facilities that support current and future populations.

As funding allows, the next priority projects are:

- SW 24/SW Hume/SW 25th between Barbur Blvd and Multnomah Blvd;
- SW 40th and Huber Rapid Flash Beacon crosswalk
- SW Custer between SW 13 and SW 17th.
- SW Capitol Hill Road, Safeway to Christian School (200 feet)
- SW Miles from Barbur (Community Garden) to Fulton Community Center
